MVP Winter Propane Safety Tips

- Install a propane gas and carbon monoxide detector in your house and other buildings you are heating with propane. Follow manufacturer recommendations for the placement of detectors.
- Review your Propane Safety Information pamphlet that MVP sends out every spring. Please pay particular attention to the Sniff Test portion of the pamphlet.
- Mark your propane tank with a flag, pole, or stake that is higher than both your tank and average snowfall depth in your area. Please make sure you do not drive the marker through any buried propane line. Marking the tank will prevent you from plowing into the tank or placing additional snow on top or around the tank.
- Always maintain a clear path to your propane tank. Failure to do so could result in a delay in the delivery of your propane.
- **STOCK UP ON PROPANE.** MVP recommends ordering propane when your tank reaches 30%. With winter road conditions and high demand, ordering at 30% allows MVP adequate time to complete your order.
- **KEEP SNOW AND ICE FROM ACCUMULATING ON YOUR PROPANE EQUIPMENT.** Pay particular attention to your second stage regulator located at the house. Use a broom or your hand to clear snow or ice from all propane equipment. If you must use a shovel, exercise extreme caution. If any snow or ice cannot be removed please call MVP.
- Clear roof above propane equipment to prevent ice and snow from falling on and damaging equipment.
